Iona Abbey is located on the little island of Iona in the Inner hebrides off the west coast of Scotland. It has been a place of pilgrimage since Saint Columba who in the 6th century brought Christianity to Scotland and beyond. Saint Columba was exiled from Ireland and created a small monastic community in Iona. The monastery had a small church and individual monastic cells for sleeping in.

Iona Abbey was destroyed by Viking raiders in the ninth century AD. In the 1930s the abbey was rebuilt and, in 1991, a Catholic prayer house was established and Mass began to be celebrated on the holy island once again.

In silence, let us take a moment to think about people in our lives who work hard to give us what we need.


